More projects for Roundwood
Art and Eco Public Project (e.g. sculptures cleaning the air) – 6 VOTES
Eco infrastructures (Lights Park Road) – 1 VOTE
Continuation and Safety – Forest School in Roundwood – 2 VOTES
Fashion Show – 2nd hand clothing
More allotment/community gardens
BEE Colourful re-run on high streets/More flowers & plants, working with businesses – 6 VOTES
Longstone Avenue, Community Orchard & Planting – 3 VOTES
Signage/ashtrays or areas in parks about smoking and public health
Enforcement on paving over gardens
Dropped kerbs enforcement on illegality – 1 VOTE
Getting rid of knotweed
Dog poo on streets needs tackling – signage education, more enforcement officers -
Tackling flytipping – Fix My Street/More Enforcement/Bulky Waste – 7 VOTES
Park wardens – Bramshill Open Space – 1 VOTE
Bulky waste – expansion of the free offer. People can't afford £35
More clothes banks in this area – i.e. Church Path – 1 VOTE
